### PROJECT BACKGROUND

- In 1994, Tustin City Council was designated as the Local Reuse Authority, overseeing future development of Tustin Legacy — encompassing the acreage from the Marine Corps Air Station Tustin that closed in 1999.
- **Navy North Hangar Update:** This site spans 85 acres of Navy-owned land that includes the North Hangar that was damaged by fire in 2023. The City is developing a Reuse Plan to help guide future decisions, including a possible land transfer from the Navy.
- **Navy South Hangar Decision Ahead:** Located on land leased from the Navy, the South Hangar sits at the heart of the Tustin Legacy urban core. The City is evaluating options for its future use, with health, safety, community benefit and long-term costs under consideration.
